**Title: Winter Blues**

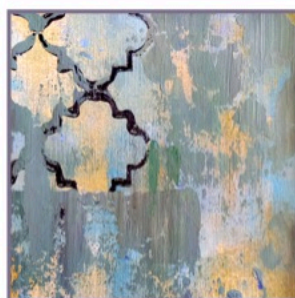
