I have lots to tell you. Are you sitting comfortably?... then I'll begin.

2023 was a very good year for StreetLife.

We know the shelters are still inundated with unwanted dogs / strays, but StreetLife is doing



everything we can to help reduce the number of unwanted puppies.

Yes, at times, it's an uphill struggle; but with all of us working together, we are more than

In 2023 we spent €31,049 with our Partner Vets, this is 28% more than in 2022

Since we launched StreetLife we have spent €126,266.74 on sterilisations... helping families on low incomes and animal shelters.

Counting dogs ... Facts and figures...




Total applications at the end of 2023

As you can see from the figures below we received 29% more applications from January to December 2023 compared to the same time period in 2022.


In 2023 we received 281 applications.


The number of sterilisations will never match the number of applications in a year. Some applications are received one year and the sterilisation is in

the next year.
Some owners cancel & some applications outside our area do not get approved. Some dogs are too old or too sick to be operated on.

In 2023 more applications were via our StreetEyes, compared to during Covid when most applications were on line.

We need more StreetEyes because face to face is always better as we can assess the dog/home situation.





It will come as no surprise we receive more females for sterilisation than males.

Our official sterilisation figure is when we post a dog on Facebook and not before. At that stage we know their success story is complete, the dog has recovered and the vet has been paid.




WELCOME to the StreetLife Association Team

What changes in 2024?



New bigger area...

In February 2024 we increased our area to cover the whole of Sotavento / East Algarve. The East Algarve has always been the area we cover; but we have only supported part of Loulé not all of it. We have now decided to cover all of Loule... the Sotavento area.



StreetLife Partner Shelters

We now have our **StreetLife Partner Shelters** who we work with to spread the word about sterilisation. StreetLife's role will be to provide exposure on our social media platforms for our Partner Shelters and assist in funding for shelter related sterilisations.

The role of the Partner shelters and their volunteers, friends and supporters will be to spread the word about "Be Wise - Sterilise!"... hopefully reaching low-income families living in the countryside near their shelters. We also invite the shelters to help with any campaigns we have... like our last one in February.

The current **StreetLife Partner Shelters** are:

APAR, ADAPO, A Dogs Life, Benafim Dog Rescue, Cacela Dog Haven and 2ndhand4footers plus a few private individuals who are heavily into animal welfare.

Portuguese Website revamp

Towards the end of last year we had to remove our Portuguese website because we had problems with the size... it was getting too big for the hosting package we were using.

In January this year we updated our package, increasing the size so we now have more space for our English and Portuguese websites.

In the coming weeks the new revised Portuguese website will be launched. We will let you know when it's available.

February Be Wise - Sterilise Campaign

StreetLife tries at least once per year to have a sterilisation campaign to encourage more families to get their dogs sterilised. During February, all pregnant females were sterilised for free and all other dogs for €30.00. We had 56 applications during the month. We always needs lots of helpers during a campaign to stick campaign posters on rubbish bins to help us spread the word. The more bins the better!



been delivered to help our sterilisation programme. Needless to say the bottles "disappear" very quickly. We clearly have many supporters who like to partake in a glass or two of "vinho".

As a result of the wine donations, €915 was raised in 2021, €1133 in 2022 and €900 in 2023 making a total of €2948 over the last three years. That's a lot of snipping as a result of "glugging" for our Be Wise - Sterilise Programme ©.

StreetBuddies are our family and friends



Since we started StreetBuddies in 2019 we have issued 108 "membership cards".

We currently have 75 active StreetBuddies.

StreetBuddies have raised €22409 (including money box donations) since the scheme started five years ago.

WOW!!!!!

Every single StreetBuddy is making a difference

We have "lost" 33 members over the years, but NOT supporters! Sometimes someone only becomes a StreetBuddy for a year, or they donate a membership to someone as a gift, or they move out of our area, or they are helping other animal associations... there are many reasons "memberships" do not continue BUT they all whole heartedly still support our sterilisation programme. That's important. Supporters spread the word!

These mornings are twice per year, usually in June and December. It gives the StreetLife Team the opportunity to chat to some of our supporters and update you on our activities.

At the last coffee morning in December 2023 to celebrate our 1000th sterilisation, we had 70 StreetBuddies and supporters ... we hope this level of support continues. The morning had such a buzzy friendly atmosphere, it was so good to see everyone having a good time and for a very good reason!

The number of sterilisations our supporters have helped us to achieve is outstanding and we are so proud of everyone. Long may it continue. What a fantastic team we make!
