I also tried something new..... I first added tile patterns to the canvas and then painted the seascape on top.

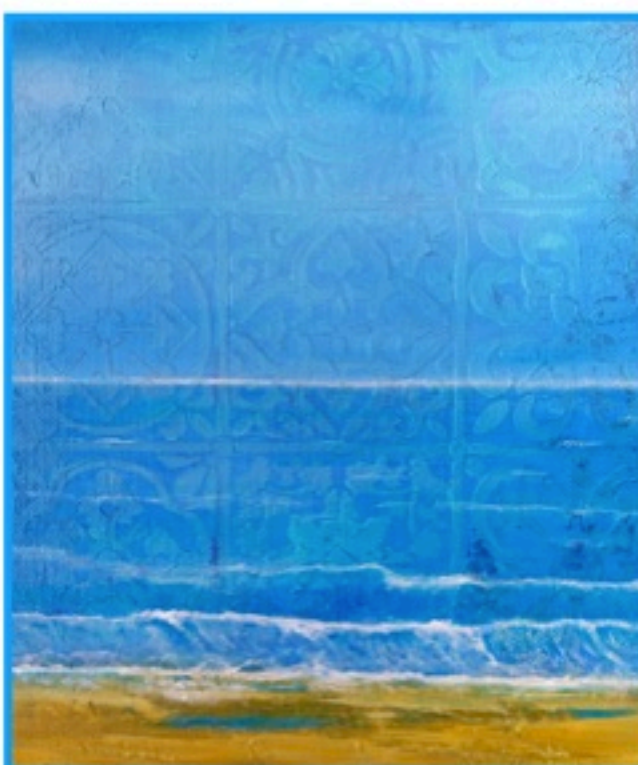
I would very much like to receive some feedback. Please let me know what you think about this combination.
